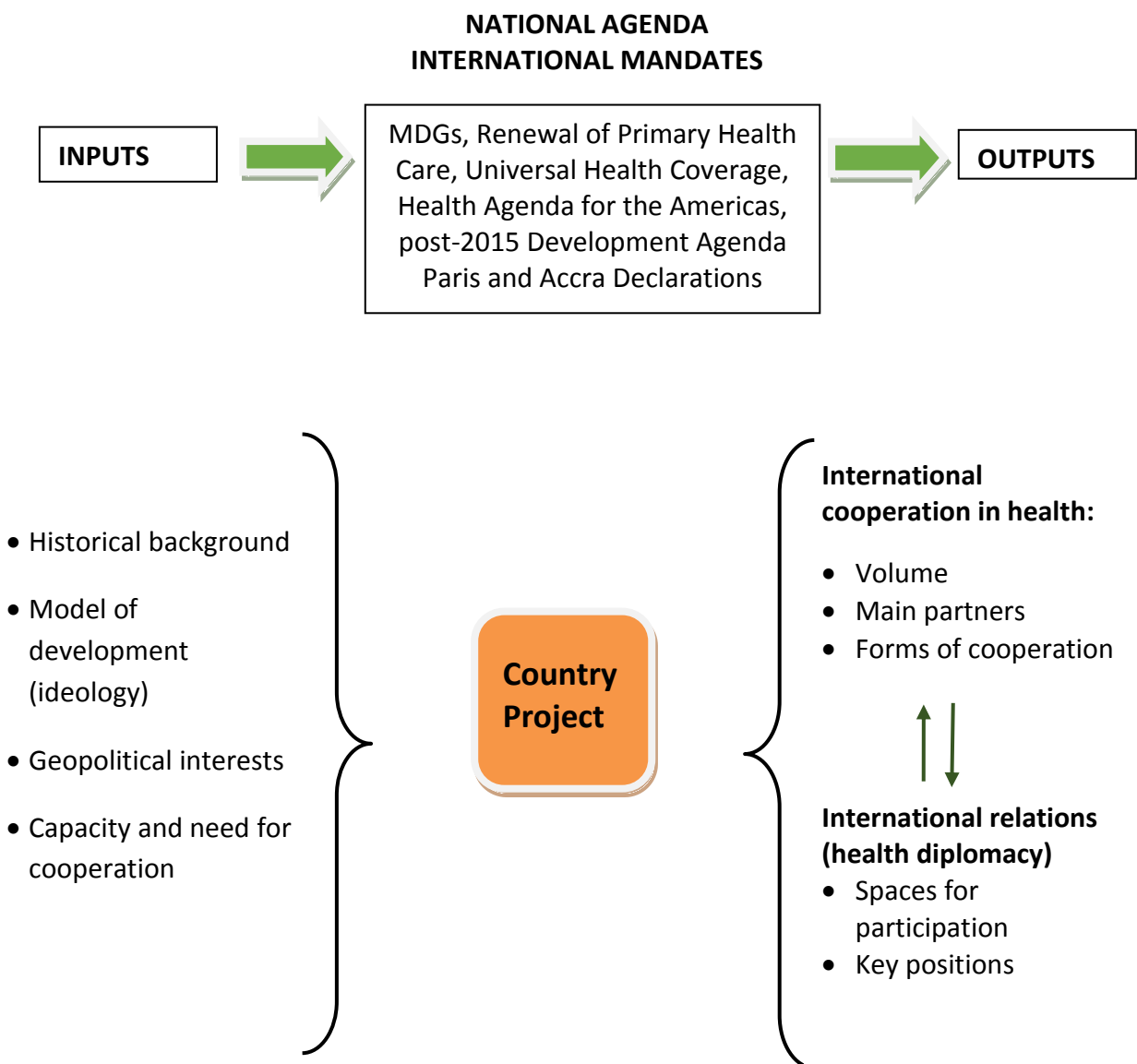


MODEL OF ANALYSIS OF FOREIGN POLICY AND INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION APPLIED TO THE COUNTRY TOPIC



Each element can be characterized as follows:

INPUTS: Based on a national perspective and the country context and those aspects that constitute determining factors in the analysis and definition of the topic.

OUTPUTS: These are elements that are not dependent on the national reality or context but rather the interaction of the selected country topic with external factors that influence how it is addressed and which are determining factors in the result.

Central elements: These are the regional and international agendas, health policies and mandates that constitute guidelines for the adoption of national strategies.
