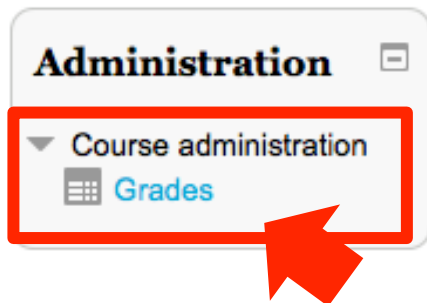


Grades

Grading Scales

There are two qualitative scales for grading learning activities in the Virtual Campus for Public Health:

Final Scales which is only for the final grade: Passed with Excellence, Passed with Distinction, Passed, and Failed.
